## Alerts and guidance

#### 1.1 LDK utilities and run-time reminder

If you're using LDK security, please remember:

LDKTool and LDKUtil will no longer work for activating LDK licenses after Nov  $3^{rd}$  2020. You *must* use version 2 of these utilities, as shipped with Harlequin 13.0r0 and later, and available on the Global Graphics FTP site.

The LDK 7.100 run time and earlier will not work on Windows 10 build 2004; you must use run time 7.103, as shipped with Harlequin 13.0r0 and later.

#### 1.2 Windows compiler

MSVC 16.4 or later was recommended for Harlequin 13.0r0. This is updated to MSVC 16.7 or later for Harlequin 13.0r1.

## 1.3 BlackTint now applied to smooth shades

The BlackTint setinterceptcolorspace key can now be applied to some smooth shades as well as to fill, strokes and text. If your configuration sets BlackTint to false, then output may change for jobs containing shadings. Black tint preservation is not exposed in the user interface, but may be configured in a page feature, plugin setup code etc. You can control the object types to which is will be applied by using a dictionary value for BlackTint, setting the value of its Vignette key to true. #### 2.1 Avoiding a new cause of invalidfont errors (HQN-382235)

We've seen a significant number of reports over the last few months of a new problem with fonts embedded in PDF files, coming in from multiple OEMs and from multiple sectors of the printing industry.

The error is reported as invalidfont, with an "offending command" that's one of the PDF text painting operators such as Tj, although, of course, many other badly formed fonts can trigger that same report.

The cause of many of the new incidences of this problem has been that the PDF files contain an embedded TrueType font which is invalid because it does not contain a CMap table. The error is therefore correct behavior. But we've also found in these new cases that the CMap table is not actually used. So, for Harlequin 13.0r1 we have moved the code to trigger the error such that it is now called only if the font attempts to use a missing CMap.

We have not been able to pin down the cause for this new wave of problems. We've noticed that many (but not all) of the examples that we have been sent use fonts from the Google font library (https://fonts.google.com/). Some reports have also implicated the OpenType Sanitizer (OTS). Whatever the cause, it's clear that something new has been widely adopted in the resources or tools used for PDF creation, which is why we're bringing out a change in Harlequin 13.0r1 to allow your customers to process these PDF files.

## 3.2 Updates to supported platforms and compilers

Harlequin MultiRIP 13 requires the 64-bit version of Windows.

- Windows 8.1 (requires SP1, excludes Windows RT)
- Windows Server 2012 R2 (Standard Edition only, excludes Server Core configuration)
- Windows 10 workstation (excludes Windows Mobile and Mobile Enterprise, embedded and IoT Core).
- Windows Server 2016 (Standard Edition only, excludes Server Core, Nano-server configurations)
- Windows Server 2019 (excludes Server Core, Nano-server, Windows Server 1809 configurations); from HMR 12.1.

Plugins should be compiled with MSVC 2019, v16.7 or later (from HMR v13.0r1).

#### 3.3 Installers

Installers provided by Global Graphics Software are now built using InstallAnywhere 2020 (HQN-381462).

#### 3.4 LDK Run-time

Harlequin v13.0r1 is shipped with LDK Run-time v7.103. See also Section 1.1.

## 3.5 Plugins and utilities

Any plugins distributed with this release are supplied solely for use with the Harlequin MultiRIP v13.

The Harlequin MultiRIP will support OEM and third-party plugins using input and output, color management and screening APIs.
